

APPLICATION

ATN 8x36RF daytime Omega class binocular provide a sharp stable image with excellent low-light performance.

The combination of waterproof and high quality optics make this the perfect binocular for boating and law enforcement, as well as most hunting uses.

EYE ADJUSTMENTS

How to adjust for distance between your eyes:

The distance between the eyes, called "interpupillary distance," varies from person to person.



To achieve perfect alignment of lens to eye, follow these simple steps:

1. Hold your binocular in the normal viewing position.

2. Grasp each barrel firmly. Move the barrels closer together or farther apart until you see a single circular field. Always reset your binocular to this position before using.

FOCUSING

Focus the binocular for one eye at a time by turning the ocular (eyepiece) until you see an equally sharp image with each eye. If more then one person will be using the binocular, you should



mark the left and right eyepieces for your own vision to permit quick readjustment.

ROLL-DOWN EYECUPS

Your binocular fitted with rubber eyecups designed to exclude extraneous light. If you wear eyeglasses, you may be able to roll-down the eyecups. For eye-



glass wearers, lowering or rolling down the eyecups will bring your eyes closer to the binocular lenses, thus providing an improved field of view.



RANGEFINDER RETICLE

8x36RF has a built-in step rangefinder with a mils scale for distance, angle and height detection.



DISTANCE

If the height of a viewed object is known, use the following equation substituting height of object for variable H:

 $L = H/MILS \times 1000$

ANGLE

To calculate the included angle of a

viewed object, use the following formula:

 $x^{\circ} = 0.06 \text{ x MILS}$

HEIGHT

If the distance to a viewed object is known, use the following equation substituting distance to object for variable L:

 $H = L \times MILS/1000$

2M TARGET BASED SCALE

A 2m target fits between the numbered baseline and the main horizontal line. If the 2m target fits between the 4 and the right horizontal post of the main line the target is 400 m away. If the same target fits between the 7 and the right post of main line the target is 700 m away.



If a 2m target fits between these two lines then the target is 400m away. If a 2m target fits between these two lines then the target is 700m away.

CARE AND CLEANING

By following these simple guidelines, your binocular will provide optimal performance for many years:

1. Keep binocular lenses clean and free of moisture and dirt.

2. When not in use, do not expose your binocular to direct sunlight for long periods of time (e.g. on the dashboard of your vehicle).

3. Store your binocular in a cool, dry place. Always store your binocular in its carrying case, with the rubber roll-down eyecups in the "up" position.

4. Binocular is precision instruments - handle them with care. Do not drop, shake, bump or rattle your binocular. Its precision optics can become misaligned (out of collimation) as a result of rough treatment, which can render the instrument virtually unusable.

Collimation problems usually require repair by a trained technician, and are generally not covered by the Warranty.

To clean your binocular, follow these simple steps:

 Before attempting to clean any of the lenses, carefully remove all grit, sand, dirt, dust, or other substances which may scratch the surface of the optics. Avoid touching lens surfaces with fingers or coarse materials. Use a soft lens brush, lens cleaning tissue, a lint-free cotton cloth, a clean cotton swab, or "canned" air.

2. For materials that remain on the lenses, use a liquid substance designed to remove grease (e.g., commercial lens cleaner, household window cleaner or rubbing alcohol).

CAUTION: Do not apply liquid directly onto a lens, which may result in the liquid seeping into the barrel of the binocular. Apply the solution onto a cloth or swab, and use the cloth or swab to remove the foreign substance with circular motions. Take care as to not rub away antireflectant lens coatings. Use a light touch.

WARRANTY

2 YEAR PRODUCT WARRANTY

This product is guaranteed to be free from manufacturing defects in material and workmanship under normal use for a period of 2 (two) years from the date of purchase. In the event a defect that is covered by the foregoing warranty occurs during the applicable period stat-ed above, ATN, at its option, will either repair or replace the product, and such action on the part of ATN shall be the full extent of ATN's liability, and the Customer's sole and exclusive remedy.
